Dear students and partners,

we would be delighted to receive your nominations for Erasmus+ exchange, free-mover students, as well as students coming from institutions based in countries that participate in bilateral agreements with the Republic of Croatia for the academic year 2022/2023.

In order to find out which mobility scheme applies to you, we strongly advise contacting your home institution's international coordinator/mobility office.

Are there any special requirements/prerequisites for application?

The only universal requirement (for all the incoming students) is the B2 English language certificate. Additionally, students on ERASMUS⁺, CEEPUS, freemover and Bilateral agreements and schemes are required to enrol into a minimum of 30 ECTS credits per semester.

How to apply for a mobility at Faculty of Kinesiology?

The application process differs depending on the status of incoming students and the type of exchange scheme you are applying for.

Information on the application process is organised according to the application process scheme through which you are applying. A detailed list of required documents is available further down this page. Please note that, unless specified otherwise, all documents are submitted in an electronic form (either as scans or filled out submission forms). Hard copies are not required.

Application process

Students apply for financial support to CEEPUS and, when the support is granted, students contact International Relations Coordinator at the Faculty of Kinesiology.

Applications are submitted directly to CEEPUS platform. When applying, prospective students need to send:

• Letter of Acceptance (CEEPUS format document) signed and stamped by CEEPUS coordinator at the Faculty of Kinesiology (prof. Mia Perić at <u>miaper@kifst.hr</u>)

- Certificate of enrollment at your home institution
- o List of courses (30 ECTS credits) you would like to enrol at the Faculty of Kinesiology
